It gives me immense pleasure to present before you the Annual Report of RLJDMC D.A.V. Public School for the academic year 2025–26. This year has been a remarkable journey of excellence, innovation, and achievement, reflecting the collective spirit of our school community.

Academic Excellence

Our students have consistently demonstrated brilliance in academics.

1. In CBSE Secondary School Board Examination 2025 Class X, the school QPI was 78.8 in which Oishani Ghosh secured FIRST position scoring 99% marks, Soham Banerjee Second with 98.6% and Anuj Modi ranked in the Third position with 98.4% marks. They deserve genuine accolades.

In CBSE Sr. Secondary Certificate Board Examination 2025 Class XII the school QPI was 76.4, where from COMMERCE Stream Tanushree Khaitan bagged a brilliant 98.2% positioned FIRST not only in Commerce Stream but also emerged as School's Topper. Piyush Kumar Tibrewal ranked SECOND with 96% marks and Prachi Tibrewal THIRD securing 95.2% marks.

In HUMANITIES, Priya Gupta emerged TOPPER with 97% marks followed by Sahej Kour Sidhu who achieved 96.8% marks. Both of them have been the SECOND and THIRD rank holders of the school in Class XII. Swapnadipa Roy who scored 91.6% marks was in the THIRD position in Humanities. Rimjhim Laha of Science Stream achieved 94.8% marks and clinched FIRST position, followed by Aditi Dokania securing 93.6% as SECOND and Sumit Sinha secured 92% marks was THIRD.

2. It gives me immense pleasure to inform this august gathering that at the National Financial Assessment Test (NFLAT) 2024–25, organised by National Centre for Financial Education supported by RBI, Securities Exchange Board of India and others. HARSITA AGARWAL (Class XII Commerce) emerged as the East Zone Winner. She was awarded a Certificate of Merit and Amazon cash voucher worth Rs 5,000/-.
3. In competitive examinations like NEET and WBJEE 2025, our students secured commendable ranks.
Rimjhim Laha of science stream qualified NEET (UG) 2025 State rank 793. She is now studying in Bankura Govt Medical College. Kritika Mohanta of Science Stream also qualified NEET (UG) 2025 with State Category Rank 18. She is now studying at the Barddhaman Medical College.

4. Shreyam Marodia, Sumit Sinha, and Aman Kumar Sonkar all qualified WBJEE, 2025 with Merit Rank 503 and category ranks 172 and 746 respectively. They are now studying in Premier Institutions like Jadavpur University, Kalyani Govt Engineering College and Techno India (Main) Salt Lake, Kolkata respectively. Kudos to all of them.
5. In the ICSI Commerce Olympiad 2025, we celebrated outstanding success with International Topper Tanishka Gupta of Grade XI and Zonal Topper Bhoomi Khaitan of Grade XII, along with a rich tally of 09 gold, 11 silver, and 11 bronze medals clinched by 31 students of Commerce stream. A total number of 44 commerce students appeared.
6. We are extremely elated to announce that 155 students from Grade VI to XI participated in Vidyarthi Vigyan Manthan, an International competition organised by Vijnana Bharati and NCERT & NCSM. Out of those participants, about 15 students qualified for the State Level Competition held at MDB DAV Public School, Bankura on 4th January 2026. It is a proud moment for us to intimate you that Anirban Sadhu from Grade XI bagged the FIRST position, he has qualified for participation at the National Level. He has bagged a Certificate, a memento and cash prize worth Rs. 5,000/-.
7. “Youth Ideathon” 2025 organised by ThinkStartup and Management Entrepreneurship Professional Skills Council (MEPSC) in association with Central Board for Secondary Education (CBSE). Our School Students participated and were selected to Grand Finale for consecutive TWO (02) years. Our students submitted TEN Projects all together. Out of that SIX Projects were selected for TOP 2000 this year. Later on, 500 innovative projects were shortlisted and our THREE unique projects were also selected to qualify for the next level. Finally, the Screening committee shortlisted 125 projects, out of that our ONE project named ‘CARBO’ was selected for the Grand Finale at the IIT, Delhi on 18th January 2026. Our students Nafees Ansari, Sparsh Singh and Snigdho Banerjee of Grade X presented their project in front of Distinguished adjudicators. Dear distinguished gatherings, you will be delighted to know that they were awarded with Medals and Certificates of Achievements. Their mentor Teacher was Mrs. Susmita Chandra Santra.
8. I am truly happy to share another accomplishment achieved by our students in **International Hindi Olympiad- 2025-'26** which was held on 20th September 2025. Total no of students from our School who appeared in the Level-I for Grade I to X was 101(One hundred and one). Out of which, 16 students clinched Gold Medals, 09 students bagged Silver Medals and 12 students received Bronze Medals. It is a matter of great pride for our School that NINE (09) out of the 37 medal winners, qualified and appeared Level-II round. Their result is awaiting and we keep our fingers crossed.

2. Wild Wisdom Global Challenge 2025 conducted Quiz contest. About 30 students participated from Grades VI to IX. In a tie breaker round two (02) students Ankan Mondal of Grade VIII and Khushi of Grade IX qualified for Zonal Level where our School bagged the FIRST position and qualified for the National Level. Finally, in the National Level, our School secured FOURTH position amongst 08 teams from four zones of the country.
3. At the All Bengal Inter-School Mega Quiz ‘QUEST-2025 held at Srijani Auditorium, Durgapur on July 12, 2025 our school team members Marang Buru Kisku,(XII) Snigdho Banerjee and Harshit Maskara(VIII) showcased their exceptional knowledge and skills, qualifying through the 1st and 2nd rounds, secured 4th position out of 142 schools, winning a cash prize of ₹6,000.
4. On 2nd May 2025, students of our school participated in the Inter School Quiz Competition, conducted by JIS group at Delhi Public School, Durgapur. After qualifying the written preliminary round, our school qualified among the Top 08 teams out of total 49 teams. Marang Buru Kisku,(XII) and Harshit Maskara(VIII) have secured the 4th position.
5. In the Brain Zoom Quiz Competition organised by Zoom International School, Durgapur, our junior team of Kaivalya Krishna and Kushal Choudhary both from Grade VIII stood among the top finalists, earning cash awards of Rs. 6,000/-
6. Tulsi Jayanti- A celebration of tradition, culture and values, various competitions were organised on 20th & 27th July 2025 at Rajendra Bhavan, Durgapur to celebrate the birth

anniversary of the great poet Goswami Tulsidas Ji. About 300 students from 14 different schools participated. Among them, Kushal Khaitan of Grade VIII secured FIRST position and Shivam Kumar Yadav of Grade VII achieved the THIRD position.

7. We applaud the participation of Ishan Gorai and Shreya Mukherjee of Grade XII for participating in a three-day Model United Nations (DAVMUN 6.0) hosted by DAV Model School, Durgapur from 06.08.2025 to 09.08.2025. Ishan won a certificate and trophy for “Special Mention” from the United Nations General Assembly (UNGA).
8. Two students of our school from std. VIII, Kaivalya Krishna and Kazi Tasin had participated and bagged the 2nd position amongst the 28 participating schools in the Inter School Mega Quiz organised by Techno India Group Public Schools.
