

- 2. ईश्वर सच्चिदानंद स्वरूप, निराकार सर्वशिवितमान न्यायकारी दयालु अजन्मा अनंत, निर्विकार अनादि अनुपम, सर्वाधार सर्वेश्वर सर्वव्यापक, सर्वातयामी, अजर अमर अभय, नित्य पवित्र और सृष्टिकर्ता है, उसी की उपासना करने योग्य है। Ishvara is existent, intelligent and blissful. He is formless, omnipotent, omniscient and omnipresent, just, merciful, unborn, endless, unchangeable, unaging, immortal, fearless, eternal, holy and the maker of all.
